KPEP is committed to detecting and preventing sexual harassment and sexual abuse in all of our facilities. Staff training and education is a key component in prevention efforts. Policies and procedures are in place and KPEP will continue to take steps to ensure the safety of our staff and clients. The resident intake provides clear information about the zero tolerance policy and the definitions of sexual abuse and harassment. Residents are provided with multiple avenues in which to report concerns.

There were a total of 6 allegations made in 2024. There were no significant patterns noted from 2023 to 2024. The population remained steady and there were no notable increases in any category. Case managers are detailed in their orientation with clients when reviewing PREA and the zero tolerance policy. All allegations of sexual abuse or harassment that were reported were investigated per KPEP policy and PREA standards. Of the 6 allegations made, 4 were unsubstantiated with 2 unfounded. In those instances there was no evidence to corroborate the allegations and local law enforcement closed the cases. There were no substantiated allegations in 2024.

Corrective Actions:

No areas of corrective action were identified as a result of incident reviews. KPEP works closely with the Michigan Department of Corrections to identify and implement appropriate training.

Areas of Improvement:

No areas of improvement were identified as a result of incident reviews. Working with the Michigan Department of Corrections, ways to ensure staff understanding of boundaries and overfamiliarity are addressed on an ongoing basis.
